

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

All students, inclusive of International and domestic students are required to meet the minimum English language proficiency requirements for entry into Kent Institute Australia's (Kent) courses. There are a number of ways to demonstrate your English language proficiency.

Kent recognises a variety of formal English tests, which can be taken to meet Kent English language proficiency requirements. The following are the minimum scores required for Kent courses.

NB: English test scores are only valid if they are less than 2 years old at the commencement of the course.
