Evidentiary Requirements:

- All documents will be verified by the relevant authority
- In case of agricultural Income, ITRS are mandatory along with the Agriculture income i.e. Revenue office/Tehsildar's certificates.
- Bank account statements are required if the funds are held in a savings account. Clear copy of a term deposit is required if showing the same.
- Letter from the employer mentioning the withdrawal amount is required in case of Provident funds of the parents. N.b.: In case the applicant is married, provident funding from parents is not acceptable. Funds must be shown in a savings account in the applicant's name, accompanied with relevant evidence.
- Where applicable, a fully sanctioned Education Loan letter is required from the bank including the bank's contact numbers (landline), contact person and Security Documents are required. PS: - Education loan sanctioned against term deposits as security are not acceptable.
- Post office funds are not acceptable.
- In case of substantial and recent transactions into a savings account, the source of those transactions is required and must be evidenced.
- Official Email ID's and landline contact numbers for Banks are required in case of a term Deposit or Loan.

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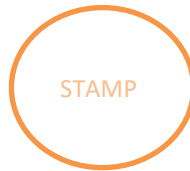
