If you have flu-like symptoms

If you have severe difficulty breathing, call triple zero (000) immediately and tell the call handler and the paramedics on arrival about your recent travel history.

If you have recently travelled to mainland China, Iran, Italy or South Korea and have developed a fever or respiratory symptoms, it is very important that you <u>call before visiting</u> your doctor or the hospital emergency department to describe your symptoms and travel history.
